FY18 Final Teacher Evaluation Rating Components

- **(IP) Instructional Practice – 57%**

- Based on the Palm Beach Model of Instruction
- Domain 1: Design Questions 2, 3 or 4
 - Category 1A: 15 data marks
 - Category 1B & 2: 10 data marks

- **(SPR) Student Performance Rating – 33%**

- Survey 2/3 student match except semester long acceleration courses
- Teachers must have 10 students with both pre and post-test scores
- State ELA and Math models will use the percent of students meeting expected score, the models use the local cohort models.

- **(PG) Professional Growth – 10%**

- Deliberate Practice - Professional Growth Plan

Value Added Model

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FDOE Value-added Model (VAM)

- Contribution to a change in a student's achievement on standardized test
- Calculated from a statistical measure of student learning growth

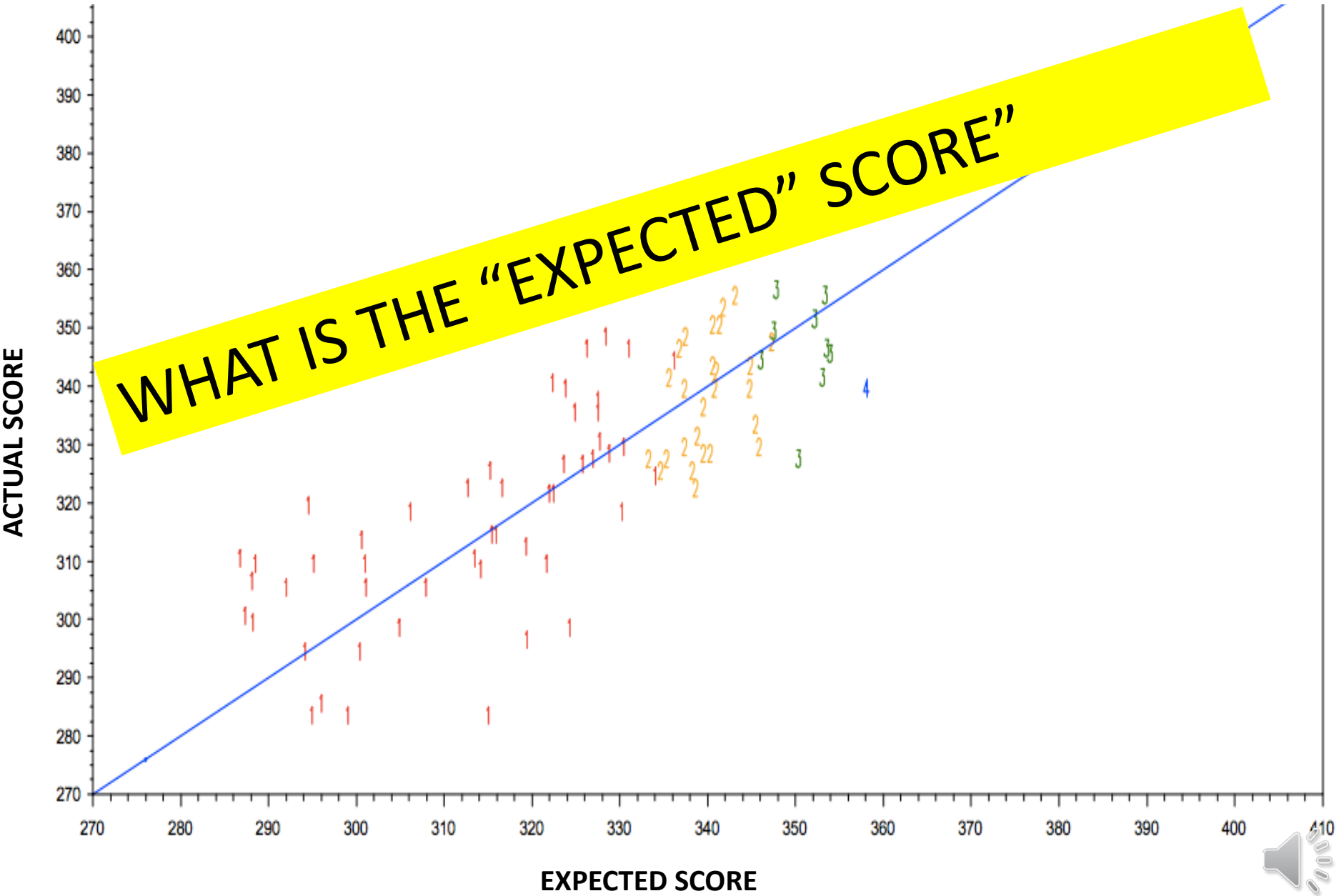
FLDOE Value-Added Model

Variables determining expected score

- **One to Two years of prior scores**
- Gifted status
- Class size
- Student Attendance (Days)
- Mobility (number of transitions)
- Difference from modal age in grade (indicator of retention)
- Number of subject-relevant courses enrolled
- Homogeneity of entering test scores in the class
- Students with Disabilities (SWD) status
- English Language Learner (LY) status

The formula approved by the District and the Joint Evaluation Negotiations Committee (JENC) specified that 57% of the final evaluation rating was from the Instructional Practice Rating, 33% was from the Student Performance Rating, and 10% was from Professional Growth. The Student Performance Rating was computed for teachers using student performance data from local, state, and national assessments depending on grade and subject taught. The Student Performance Rating for Grades 4-10 Language Arts, 3-8 Mathematics, and 8-9 Algebra continues to be determined by FDOE using the State Value Added Model (VAM). The Student Performance Rating for remaining teachers are based on District developed models that compare teacher impact to other teachers with similar students, based on prior achievement. The Student Performance Ratings for teachers who fall under multiple models are the average ratings of all applicable models.
